Applicants will be considered by the committee to be placed on a ballot that will be put before the full membership for a vote.



A director must meet the following criteria:

- be at least 18 years of age
- be a US Servas member for one year or more
- reside in the US for the entire term for which the person is elected
- able to devote 3 to 5 hours a week to the position.

The US Servas Board is a working board which manages the following functions:

- memberships
- technology
- Communications•marketing•events,
- finance•accounting•fundraising•fund management.

Directors are expected to volunteer their own time as well as manage other volunteers to fulfill the operation needs of managing US Servas. More information is provided in the application form.
